

LOCAL RULES

- OUT OF BOUNDS** Defined by White Stakes
- PENALTY AREAS** Defined by Red stakes - The red penalty area, defined by one side extend to infinity
- NO PLAY ZONE** Gardens and Young trees defined by Blue stakes - Free relief under Rule 16
- ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITION INCLUDING UNREPAIRABLE OBSTRUCTION - Rule 16**
- A. Ground Under Repair (GUR)**
- All areas marked with GUR stakes and/or marked with white paint
 - The Practice Runners located adjacent the 10th Tee are defined as GUR.
 - Free relief under Rule 16
- B. Immovable Obstructions**
- The Path on the left of the 8th green and on the right of the 11th T box, even if not artificially-surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.
 - All stakes defining Penalty areas, Distance markers, Benches, Refuse Bins, Brick Walls and Paving.
 - Within 2 club lengths from the putting green and cut to fairway height in the General Area - Free Relief (Model Local Rule F5) from all Sprinkler Heads. Relief only available, if in line of play.
 - Edging Grooves (MLR F 19) Free Relief if a player's ball lies in or interfere's with players intended swing around the apron or fringes of putting green, or putting green (rule 16.1d). No relief for stance
- C. Damage by Animals (including Mole Heaps)**
- Areas of damage in the general area caused by moles are treated as ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.
- But relief is not allowed if the damage only interferes with the player's stance.
- INTEGRAL PART OF THE COURSE**
- All bare patches and paths not artificial surfaced or mentioned above - No free relief
- NESTING BIRDS**
- If a player's ball comes to rest in or so close to a bird's nest that a stroke cannot be made without damaging the nest or interfering with the nesting bird the player **MUST**, without penalty, drop the ball within 1 club length of and not nearer the hole at the nearest spot that would allow a stroke to be made without damaging the nest or bird.
- CARTS** Motorised carts are not permitted on tee boxes, fringes and greens.
